

This nomination is judged through the aims and objectives of the project where acting as one team was implemented; how acting as one team helped deliver on the project; and the project benefits for the rail sector. All criteria should be completed for nominations to be considered, with a limit of 1250 words overall.

Additionally, this nomination should relate to activities conducted from June 2023 to June 2024. It's likely that many viable entries will overlap outside of this period, as long as the entry demonstrates that it was 'in progress' during June 2023 to June 2024 it will be accepted and judged on its merits.

Our judges will be using a points-based system which will allow them to easily benchmark each entry against each other. Each criterion is weighted equally, please ensure you take your time to demonstrate the quality over each criterion.

Any supporting evidence should be attached during the submission process. Video content to support entry will need to be submitted as a link, and images should be submitted as a .jpeg or .png file.
