This category is weighted as 100%, with organisations outlining what was achieved and why you think the outcomes merit winning this award. There is a limit of 1250 words overall.

Each nomination should relate to activities conducted from June 2022 and June 2023.

It's likely that many viable entries will overlap outside of this period, as long as the entry demonstrates that it is 'in progress' during June 2022 to June 2023 it will be accepted and judged on its merits.

Our judges will be using a points-based system which will allow to easily benchmark each entry against each other.

Any supporting evidence should be attached during the submission process. Video content to support entry will need to be submitted as a link, and images should be submitted as a .ipeg or .png file.
